CU takes workplace safety seriously. If you're injured while doing a job the university pays you to do\*, you're protected by the Workers' Compensation Act, which covers medical expenses and, following a waiting period, at least a portion of the time taken to treat and recover from work-related accidents.

### **General Information**

#### ***Your responsibilities***

- You must file a claim by reporting your work-related injury to CU within four working days of the incident (20 if you contract an occupational disease). You must provide either written notice, or complete the [University Risk Management Injury Report Form](#) <sup>[8]</sup>.
- Seek immediate and appropriate medical treatment. (Learn more about [seeking emergency care versus treatment from a designated medical provider](#) <sup>[9]</sup>.)
- Notify your supervisor of the injury so he/she can appropriately record your lost time.
- Keep your medical records for future documentation.
