Section IX: Adoption and Enablement [1]

- 1. The bylaws of the Faculty Senate shall be published and submitted to the members of the Faculty Senate, who shall vote at a Faculty Senate meeting for their approval. Sections of the bylaws that require enabling revisions to regent laws or policies shall go into effect upon approval of those revisions by the Board of Regents. Sections of the bylaws that do not require enabling revisions of regent laws or policies shall go into effect upon approval by the Faculty Senate.
- 2. The Privilege and Tenure Committee grievance procedures shall become effective after Faculty Senate approval and upon the adoption of policies by the Board of Regents incorporating the procedures described in these bylaws. The new resources, such as Committee mediators, will be implemented as soon as these resources become available.
- 3. These bylaws, if approved as described above, shall be submitted to the Board of Regents.
