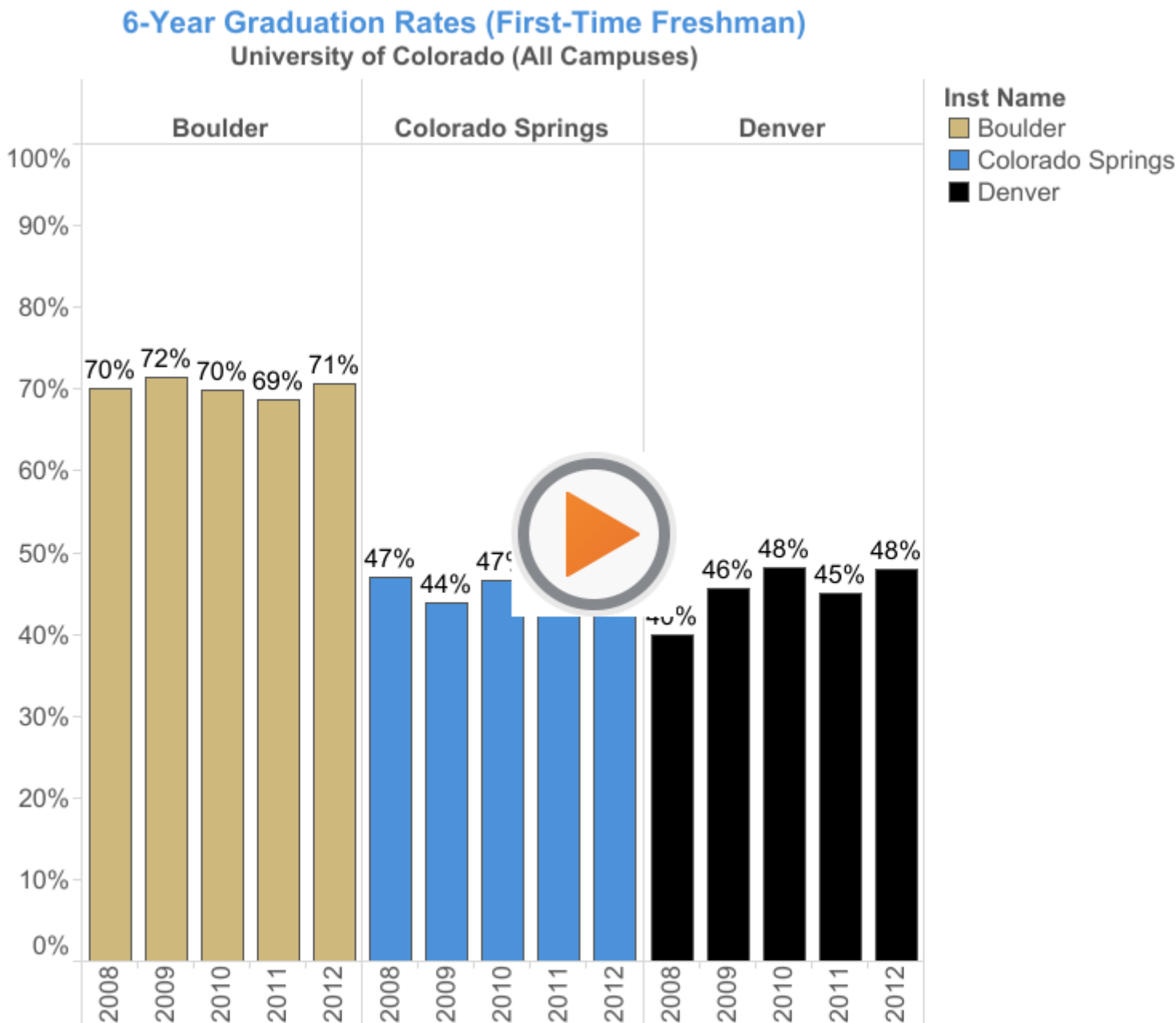


Graduation Rates of First-Time Freshman ^[1]

Graduation rates summarize a cohort of first-time freshman enrolled full-time (12 or more credit hours) in the fall term. Successful graduation is determined by successful degree completion within six years, grouped by 4-year, 5-year, and 6-year rates.
