The Treasurer of the University has established the following goals for the composition of the University's investable funds. Target percentages of Treasury Pool at market as of June 30, 2013: Cash & Fixed Income 55% ? Equities 41% ? Alternatives 4% The University's investable funds are broken into three segments. Each segment represents funds with different investment time horizons. The segment's average investment maturity is used to represent the investment time horizon.
