**CU-SIS Campus Solutions (CS) is the primary component of CU Student Integrated Systems (CU-SIS) <sup>[2]</sup> and encompasses many functions directly related to student administration, faculty workload and course management.**

Campus Solutions is made up of five modules: Admissions, Campus Community, Student Records, Student Financials and Financial Aid.

Benefits of Campus Solutions:

- Provides the ability to manage a student's entire life-cycle, from admission confirmation through graduation and beyond, including all billing activity
- Provides CU with a single system of record for all students with the flexibility to accommodate differences in student populations, campus policies and processes
- Allows for the tracking of all scheduled resources, including courses, teachers and room scheduling
- Manages complex financial aid process and monitoring of student aid
- Streamlines student administrative processes through automation

### **Request access**

To request access, you must fill out the CU-SIS Access Request Form <sup>[3]</sup>.

Each campus has module security coordinators that review and provision the appropriate access.
