

Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) ^[1]

Overview:

CU's Secure File Transfer Program (SFTP) is used by customers to upload files for batch processing and to provide short-term storage to aid in collaboration between staff and vendors.

Benefits: Some of the benefits of SFTP include:

- 24/7 file transfer services capabilities
- Centralized location for short-term file storage
- Secure file transfer for campuses, customers ([Finance](#) ^[2], [HRMS](#) ^[3], [UC4](#) ^[4], [CIW/Cognos](#) ^[5], [Campus Solutions](#) ^[6], [DATC](#) ^[7]) and vendors
- Validates and authorizes files uploaded for batch processing and storage

Who is eligible to use the service: Any CU staff member or vendor with a need to upload or download files to the university via SFTP.

How to request access to the service: Refer to the [Access](#) ^[8] website to request access to SFTP. (Note: Must be on a CU network to access this restricted website.)

Alias Information / Service History: SFTP or Secure FTP. Used to be called Dilbert.
