

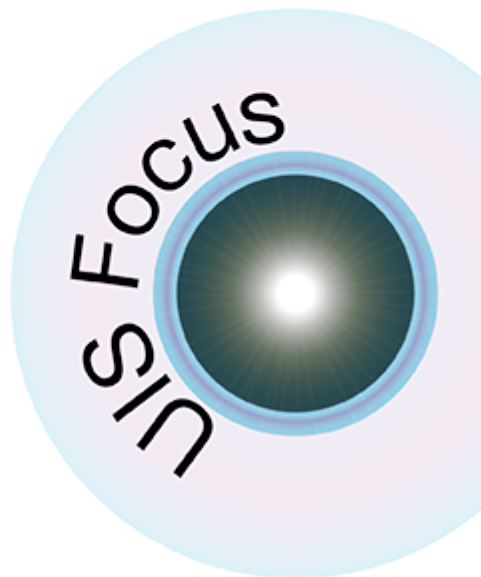
About UIS ^[1]
