The **unemployment rate** among people who have a bachelor's degree is less than half of the unemployment rate for those with only a high school diploma.

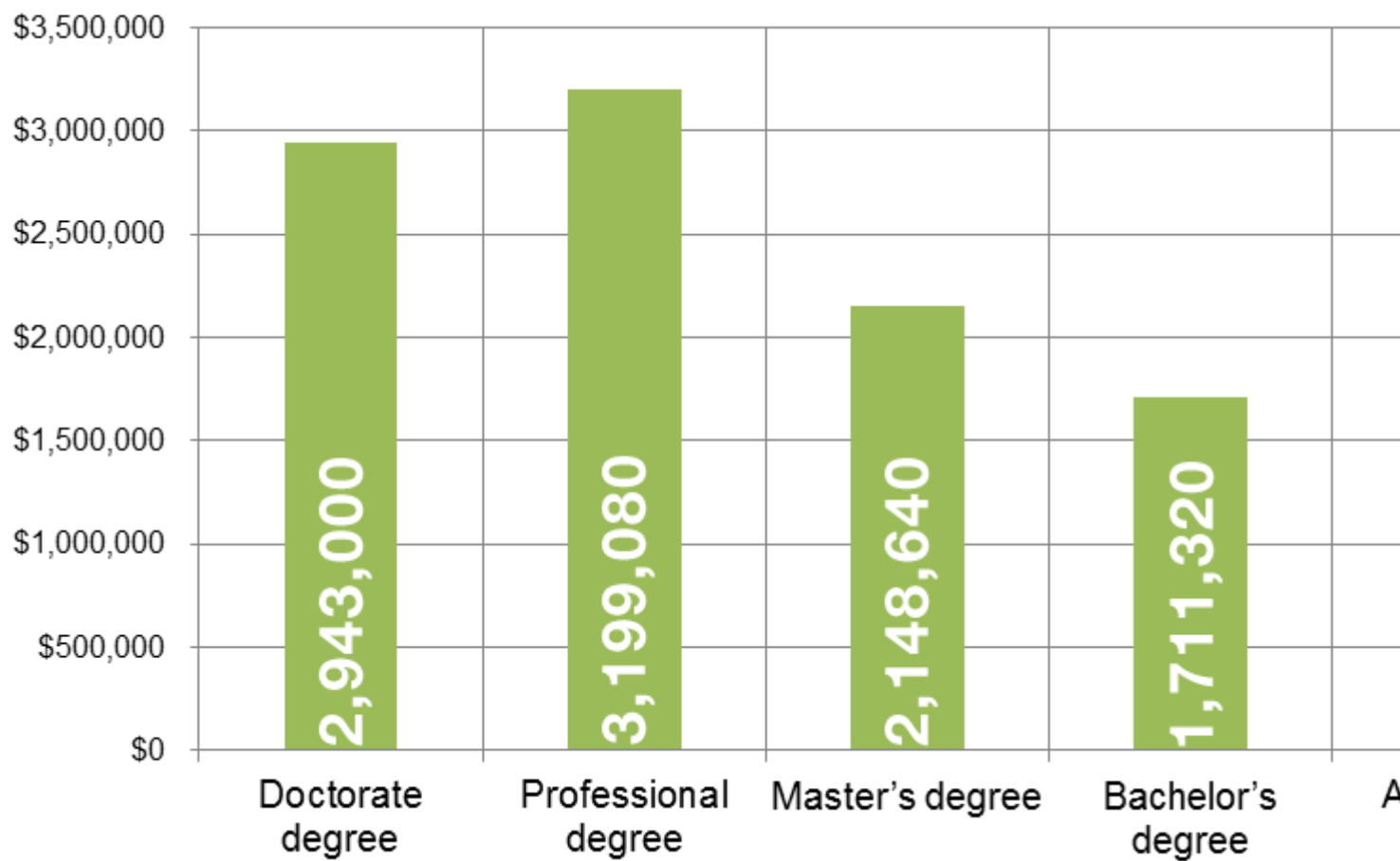
