
This document contains instruction on how to

- Configure Firefox to automatically use your Windows credentials to log in to services that use them.



How to configure Firefox to use your Windows credentials

1. With Firefox open, type in about:config in the address bar, and click enter.



How to configure Firefox to use your Windows credentials

2. Click the “I’ll be careful I promise” button to continue.



This might void your warranty!

Changing these advanced settings can be harmful to the stability, security, application. You should only continue if you are sure of what you are doing.



3. In the search bar, paste


network.automatic-ntlm-auth.trusted-uris

and press enter.



How to configure Firefox to use your Windows credentials

4. You should only get one entry. Double click enter cu.edu in the text area. Click Ok.



How to configure Firefox to use your Windows credentials

5. Note that you may need to clear your cache. Press control+Shift+Delete to bring up the history window.
6. Check Cookies and Cache and clear everything else.
7. Set the time range to Everything and click Clear Now.
8. Close and Restart Firefox
