# How to connect to VPN using the Junos Pulse Secure client for Mac OS X

1 - Download the Junos Pulse Secure  
5.1 client [here](#).

2 - Double-click the downloaded file to  
install. If prompted, install using the  
**Typical** settings.



# How to connect to VPN using the Junos Pulse Secure client for Mac OS X

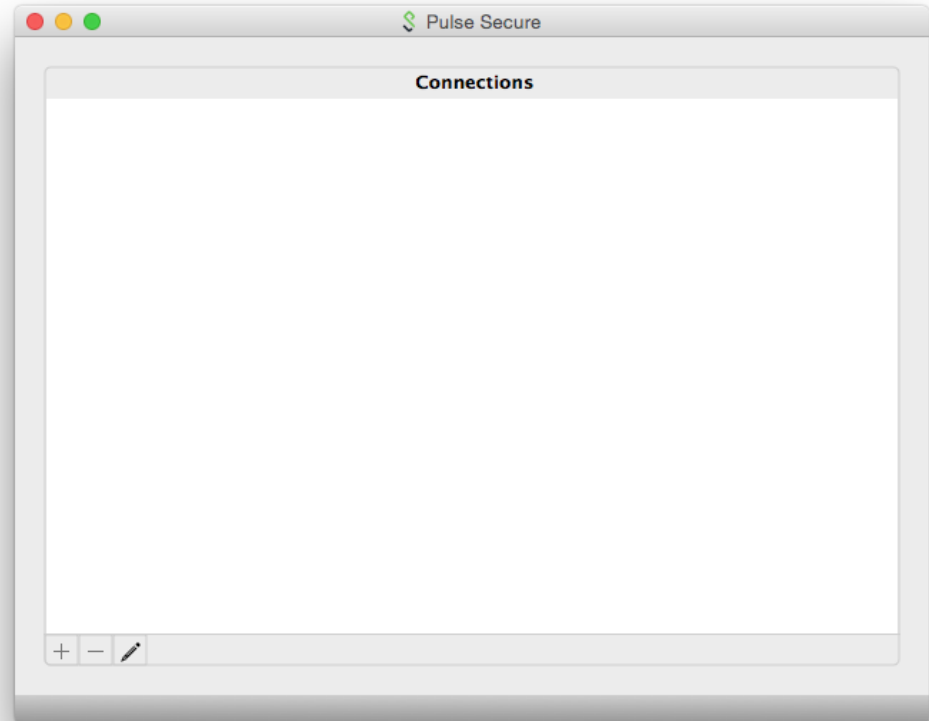
3 – Click on the **Pulse Secure** icon in the system notification tray.

You can also launch Pulse Secure from the **Spotlight Search** by searching for “**Junos Pulse**” (minus quotes).

4 – Click on the + icon to add a new VPN connection.




# How to connect to VPN using the Junos Pulse Secure client for Mac OS X

5 – Configure the connection as follows:

- Select **Policy Secure (UAC) or Connect Secure (VPN)** as the connection type
- Name the connection **System VPN**
- Enter the server URL as <https://vpn.cusys.edu>

Click **Add** to finish..

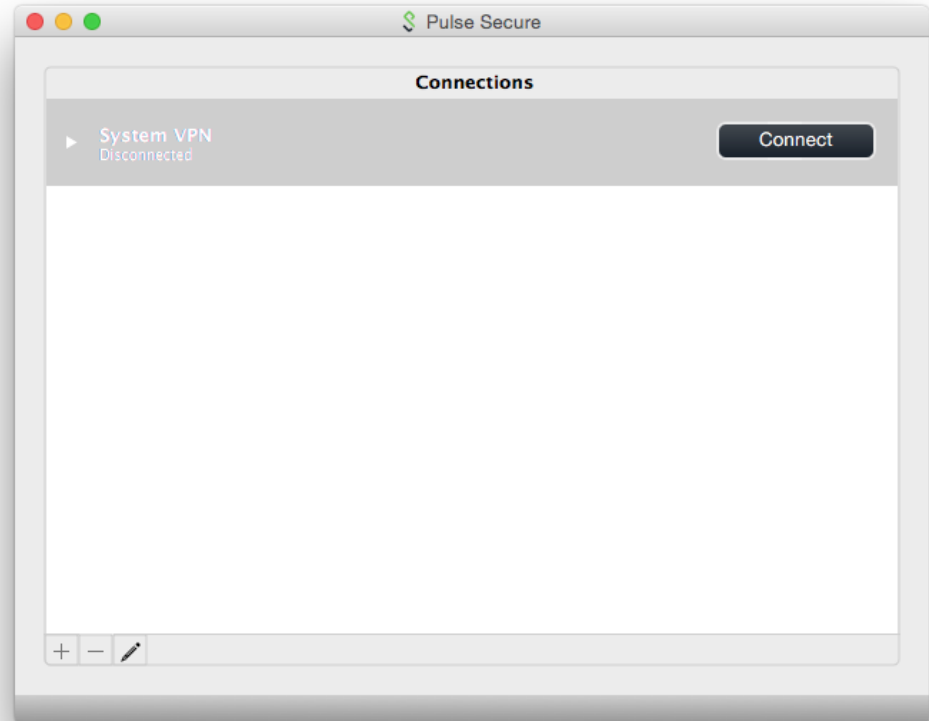

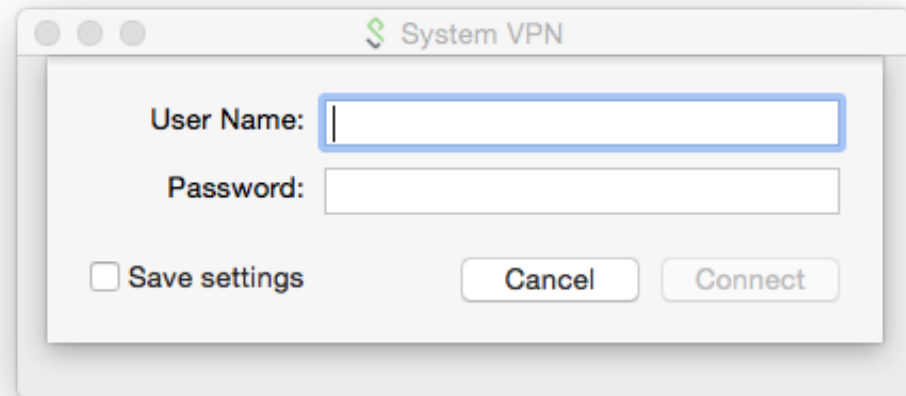

6 - On the Pulse connection window, locate the System VPN connection entry and click **Connect**

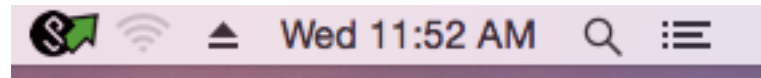
7 - When prompted, enter your System username and password, then click **Connect**. Optionally you can check the **Save Settings** box to cache your credentials for future use.



# How to connect to VPN using the Junos Pulse Secure client for Mac OS X

8 – To verify you are connected, locate the Pulse Secure icon in the system notification tray. There should be a green arrow pointing upwards, which indicates you are connected.

You are now connected to the System VPN and can connect to network resources (shared drives, terminal servers, etc.)





# How to connect to VPN using the Junos Pulse Secure client for Mac OS X

9 – To disconnect, **right-click** on the Pulse Secure icon in the system notification tray, select the **System VPN** connection profile, then click **Disconnect**.

10 – Should you want to close the application, **right-click** on the Pulse Secure icon in the system notification tray, then select **Exit**.
