Description: Concept Presentation for the Baker Residence Hall renovation. The project is a comprehensive renovation of Baker Hall in the heart of the main campus, which has seen only minor improvements since its construction in 1937. The project will modernize the 114,534 GSF facility, replace aged building systems, and bring all student residence rooms up to modern standards. The plan includes building envelope improvements, including window replacement, efficient heating and cooling, enhanced day-lighting, improved air quality. The addition of cooling to the building will support a summer conference schedule and related revenue.
