I. INTRODUCTION

As stated in Article 5.B.2(B) of the Laws of the Regents, all university employees whose duties include independent teaching and/or independent scholarly/creative work are afforded the right of academic freedom relative to these duties. This administrative policy statement defines independent teaching and independent scholarly/creative work, thereby providing clarification on who has the right of academic freedom.

II. POLICY STATEMENT

Independent teaching and independent scholarly/creative work are defined as activities that are primarily conducted free of direct oversight by another individual.

- A. Course coordinators/directors and curriculum committees are not considered to be providing direct oversight of teaching.
- B. Scholarly/creative work, including collaborative work, qualifies as independent provided the individual is directly responsible for managing their own activity or assigned work.
