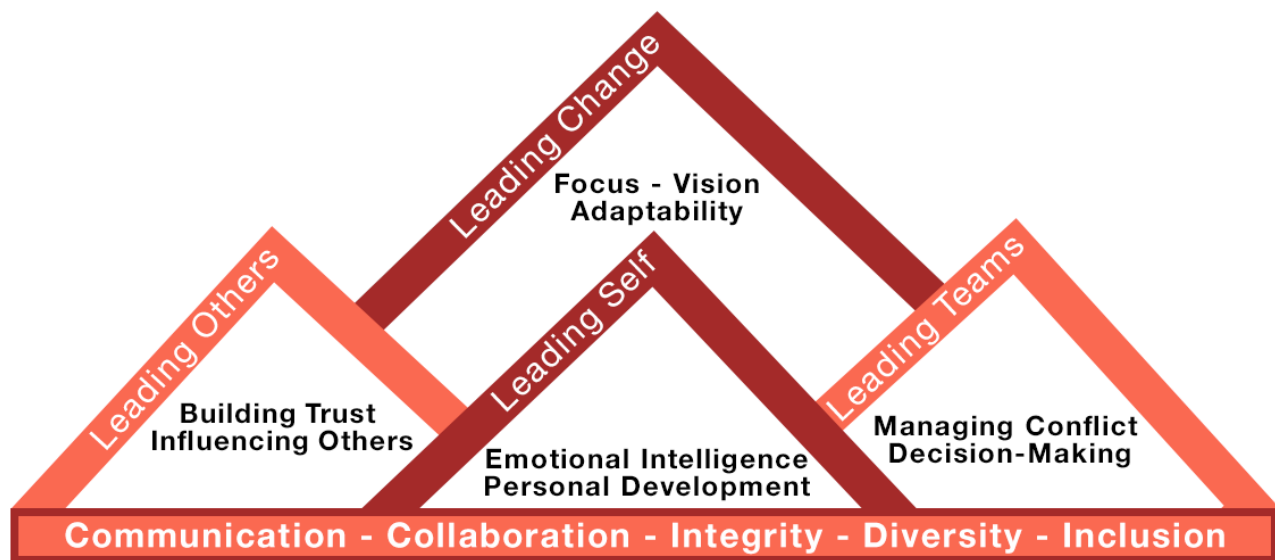




Leadership Development Program

Overview

The Leadership Development Program provides opportunities for university staff to develop leadership skills and a stronger understanding of themselves, their organizations and the university. The program runs monthly from January through June with in-person workshops, readings and online interactions. It focuses on four leadership areas.

- Exceed expectations on current performance reviews
- Express interest in developing stronger leadership skills
