1. Welcome & Announcements (Ravinder Singh, Chair EPUS)

- Reminder: SharePoint is central location for EPUS documents: [Faculty Council - EPUS - All Documents](#)
- Discussion of which Friday in April works best for an in-person meeting. Poll forthcoming.
- Faculty Council AI Ad Hoc Working Group: Draft charge shared for EPUS input. Initial feedback includes: faculty training and support (not just student-focused) and coordination with existing campus feedback to avoid duplication. Members were asked to review and submit feedback.
- EPUS Elections in April: Deborah Kenny will distribute election nominations and coordinate membership transitions. Please submit nominations for EPUS Vice Chair and Secretary by April 9th. Elections will be held on April 10th.

2. OAA Update (Michael Lightner)

- **APS 6012 (Academic Integrity and AI):** Shared additional campus feedback, including concern about overly prescriptive structure (e.g., “campus committee”). Recommendation: allow flexible, campus defined governance structures with shared governance expectation. Also emphasized importance of clarity in language and terminology.
- **Article 5C4 (Dismissal for Cause):** Near final draft. Currently under final review by legal and provosts. Expected release to EPUS within a week.
- **APS 1046 (Academic Degree Program Annual Tracking and Reporting):** Regents requested clarity on reporting/dashboard. A sample dashboard is being developed and will be included as an exemplar in the APS. Updated draft has been shared with campuses for feedback. Campuses may: adapt existing review processes to align with APS requirements.



3. Policy Updates

- **APS 6012 (Academic Integrity and AI):** EPUS submitted consolidated campus feedback to Brad Judy and Scott Munson. Brad and Scott are working on an updated draft for EPUS to review. Michael Lightner agreed to send EPUS additional input to incorporate into the next draft.
- **Regent Policy 5G and Article 5D (Faculty Grievance):** Feedback period extended through end of April. Awaiting campus feedback for final EPUS review.
- **APS 1046 (Academic Degree Program Annual Tracking and Reporting):** Updated draft 1 has been posted to the OPE website and EPUS SharePoint. Members asked to review prior to next meeting.
- **APS 1014 (Intellectual Property that is Educational Material):** Still under review. Planned for further discussion at the next meeting.
