2. Policy Updates

- APS 6012 (Academic Integrity and AI): Members need to review posted campus comments and add written input before next meeting. Chair will follow up with remaining campuses (Denver and Colorado Springs) for feedback. Chair will also invite Scott Munson to the next meeting.
- Article 5, Part D and Regent Policy 5G (Faculty Grievance): Meeting was previously held with FSGC regarding feedback. Chair requested extended deadline.
- APS 1046 (Degree Program Review): This is a new APS requiring annual Chancellor-level review of all degree programs, not a replacement for the 7-year program review cycle. Members need to review background materials and continue discussion at a future meeting.

3. Faculty Grievance Policies

- Remaining issues: EPUS discussed grievance-related language, including Regent Policy 5G, and clarified that IRC faculty do not have access to the Faculty Standing Grievance Committee (FSGC) unless grievance involves academic freedom. Members emphasized the need to clearly distinguish between jurisdictional review and the formal opening of a grievance case and agreed to revisit the language at a future meeting.
